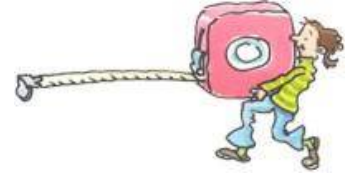

We had a great response to the last Survey. (Thank you!) We are making encouraging progress based on the 2009 survey: -- 12% reduction in carbon emissions (6% household reduction +6% absorption from planting over 30,000 trees.) Let's see where we stand now!
