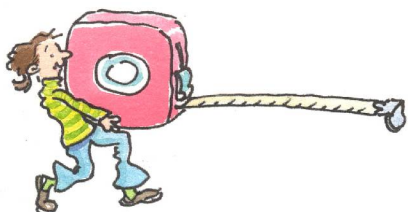

**78% of Available Eden Mills Households  
To Participate in  
Annual Emissions Survey!**

Here's a big **thank you to the neighbourhood volunteers** who have contacted every household in Eden Mills to confirm whether or not they would participate in this year's survey. Did they do a great job? The answer is a resounding yes. 78% of households they reached will take part in the survey!

### **Survey Schedule:**

**Week of January 15:** The surveys will be distributed to participating households either by e-mail or in hard copy, depending on your chosen method of reporting.

**Sunday, January 24:** Deadline for returning completed surveys.
