- **Millpond Association Update and Information Session
Wednesday, June 2, 7:30 pm, Eden Mills Community Hall**

As you know the Millpond water level has not been raised yet this spring. The meeting will provide updates and discussion on recent developments regarding the repairs for the millpond. We have so far been unable to get permits for the work we propose to do to plug the leaks, and the leaks in the riverbed are more extensive than we realized earlier.
