The community of Eden Mills is extending an invitation to attend the upcoming presentation of the Natural World Speaker Series showcasing opportunities to develop renewable energy projects. The talk will take place on Thursday May 12 at 7 pm in the Eden Mills Community Hall.

Evan Ferrari, a Program Manager for the Community Energy Partnerships Program (CEPP) will reveal how community centres, monasteries, sports clubs and hospital foundations are becoming owners and operators of renewable energy projects. "Having local, community-based ownership of solar, wind, hydro and biogas projects is crucial in transforming our electricity system to a more sustainable one," said Ferrari, Program Manager with the CEPP.

CEPP supports communities like Eden Mills, interested in getting started on early stage project development of community-based renewable energy projects. Funding of up to \$200,000 is available per project.

The Village of Eden Mills is going carbon neutral. The Village has committed to emitting no more carbon than it absorbs aiming to be the first carbon neutral village in North America and is moving forward on a variety of approaches to reducing, replacing and sequestering CO₂.
