Is a Geothermal Heat Pump Part of Your Solution? Public Workshop Saturday February 23

Eden Mills, February 6, 2007...The Eden Mills Going Carbon Neutral project announces a free two hour public workshop on Saturday, February 23. The workshop will feature information on:

- how geothermal heating and cooling systems function, including a working model
- an engineering perspective: pros and cons
- an industry panel to discuss issues and answer questions

The session, organized by Glenn Little, will begin with Jack Darmon who will present an overview of the technology. Enermodal engineer and Eden Mills resident Richard Lay will discuss the pros and cons of these systems. The concluding segment of the workshop will feature a practical discussion among panel members including representatives from Canadian Energy Developments, Tafcon Heating & Air Conditioning and Enertran Energy Transfer Systems. Libby Little will facilitate the panel discussion.

This is the first in what will be an ongoing series of information sessions designed to help citizens make informed decisions about making changes designed to reduce the production of green house gases, and to build a carbon neutral lifestyle.

The workshop will take place on Saturday, February 23rd from 10 a.m. until noon at the Eden Mills Community Hall. Admission is free.
